Request for Trading Halt pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Abundant Produce Limited requests a Trading Halt be granted by the Australian Securities Exchange in respect of its securities with effect immediately. For the purposes of ASX Listing Rule 17.1, and in support of its request, ABT advises that:

- 1. the trading halt is requested pending an announcement by ABT concerning an application to be removed from the official list;
- 2. it requests that the trading halt remain in place until the earlier of such time as it makes an announcement to the market about the removal and the commencement of trading on Monday, 2 March, 2020; and
- 3. it is not aware of any reason why the Trading Halt should not be granted or any other information necessary to inform the market about the Trading Halt.
