# **Sydney Airport Traffic Performance December 2021**

Total passenger traffic in December 2021 was 1,198,000 passengers, down 69.7% on the corresponding period in 2019.

Domestic passenger traffic totalled 949,000 in December 2021, down 59.6% on the corresponding period in 2019.

248,000 international passengers passed through Sydney Airport in December 2021, down 84.5% on the corresponding period in 2019. Traffic in December was lower than anticipated as a consequence of reduced demand, cancellations and lower load factors due to the Omicron outbreak.

For the first 15 days of January, provisional data indicates international passenger traffic was down approximately 85% and domestic passenger traffic was down approximately 58% on the prior corresponding period in 2019.

The outlook for passenger traffic continues to remain subdued due to tightly controlled inbound international travel, entry requirements and restrictions into key overseas markets, and the significant domestic flight cancellations announced for Q1 2022.
