Commencement of Federal Court Hearing

Sydney, Australia – Global software company Nuix ('the Company', ASX: NXL) refers to its previous announcements in relation to the civil penalty proceedings commenced by ASIC in September 2022 concerning alleged contraventions of the continuous disclosure regime in the period between January and April 2021. The proceeding also alleges that members of the then Board contravened section 180 of the Corporations Act.

Those proceedings commence for hearing in the Federal Court of Australia on 20 November 2023. The hearing is scheduled to occur over 4 weeks.

Nuix is defending the proceedings and maintains that its disclosure over that period was appropriate.

ASIC will make its opening submissions over two days, following which Nuix will make its opening submissions in response. Nuix anticipates that the matter may attract media attention as it progresses, however, as the matter is before the Court, the Company will not provide commentary on the proceedings or respond to media questions.
